All elective and selective rotations must be pre-approved by the rotation's preceptor as well as the Program Director and Program Coordinator.

In addition to scheduled rotations, residents will be required to complete a continuity care experience a minimum of one-half day each week. This experience will occur within a General Internist's office and residents will be expected to build a panel of patients to follow throughout their training. The emphasis on development of the panel should occur during the first two years of residency.
