

## What is it?

- Research Electronic Data Capture
- Web-based database & survey tool for research
- REDCap is funded by our Clinical and Translational Science Collaborative (CTSC) grant (<http://casemed.case.edu/ctsc/>) along with institutional support

## Who is it for?

- Available to anyone doing research at any of our CTSC institutions:
  - ✓ University Hospitals
  - ✓ Case Western Reserve University
  - ✓ MetroHealth Medical Center
  - ✓ Cleveland Clinic
  - ✓ VA Medical Center
- REDCap is primarily for researchers collecting research data (including the storing of PHI fields for their research protocols)
- It is also available for use in other ways, just as for Operational Support and Quality Improvement

## Why should I use it?

- Keeps your data more organized and more secure than Excel
- You create your own forms – you can collect only the data you want
- No database knowledge needed
- Doesn't require a lot of technical knowledge like Access
- No programming required!
- No cost (yes, it's free!)
- Nothing to install
