A. Goals and Objectives:

1. Goals of the Rotation: ENT Resident education/experience in Otolaryngology-HNS clinic/OR settings. The ENT Resident(s) on MetroHealth rotation, may rotate under these G&O's.

2. Competency-based Objectives: The Department of Otolaryngology at MetroHealth Medical Center provides a full range of diagnostic evaluations and care for diseases of the ears, nose, facial structures, paranasal sinuses, pharynx, larynx, neck, thyroid, and salivary glands. The Otolaryngology Department's goal is to provide the resident/fellow with education & experience in the community setting of clinic and OR following the ACGME Competencies of Patient Care, Medical Knowledge, Practice-Based Learning and Improvement, Interpersonal Skills, Professionalism, and Systems-Based Practice.

B. Rotation Schedule: Weekly, over 2-4 months, based on clinical/surgery schedule; including both ENT Clinic, and OR.

C. Methodology to Accomplish Goals and Objectives:

1. Observe and participate in Otolaryngology with practitioner in hospital and clinic-based setting, i.e. patient care, follow up, & referral to OR.
2. Observe and participate with practitioner in OR based setting.
3. Observe clinic manager in office-based setting; i.e. scheduling, flow of patients, referrals, and general office maintenance.
