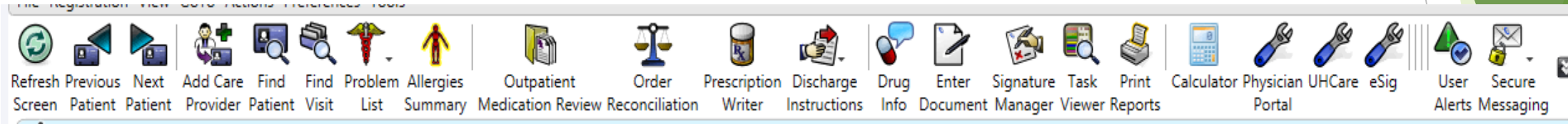

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ISBAR tool

- ▶ **I**dentification: “ Hello, My name is Ameen with Weisman Team calling for a New consult, Pt is Name, location and MRN (three identifiers)
- ▶ **S**ituation: Consult question, What is going on with the patient?
- ▶ **B**ackground: Context and relevant hx
- ▶ **A**ssessment: State what you think the problem is.
- ▶ **R**ecommendation: State your recommendation about what could be done to correct the problem.

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- ▶ H&P note: Chart review

Chart review

- ▶ Specialty Teams: State who the Primary oncologist, nephrologist, cardiologist....
- ▶ Refer to Student handbook for rotation specific instructions
- ▶ Physician portal- notes, EKG, prior Echo, EGD, Scopes (relevants)
- ▶ Clinical summary
- ▶ Medications received- useful for MICU/CICU transfers
