

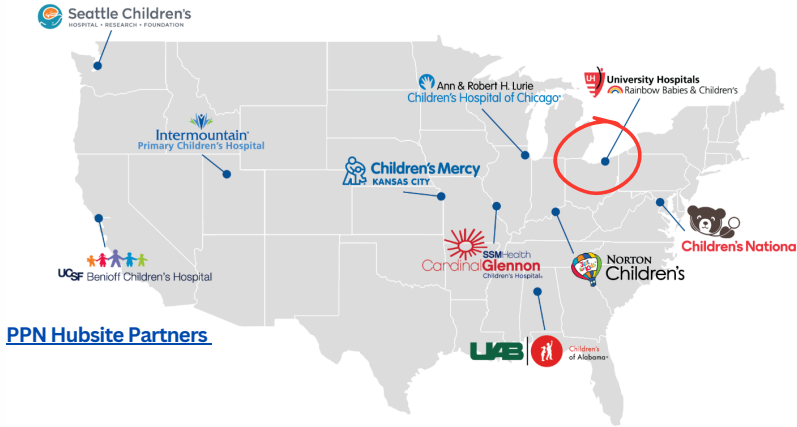
# ARE YOU (DISASTER) READY?

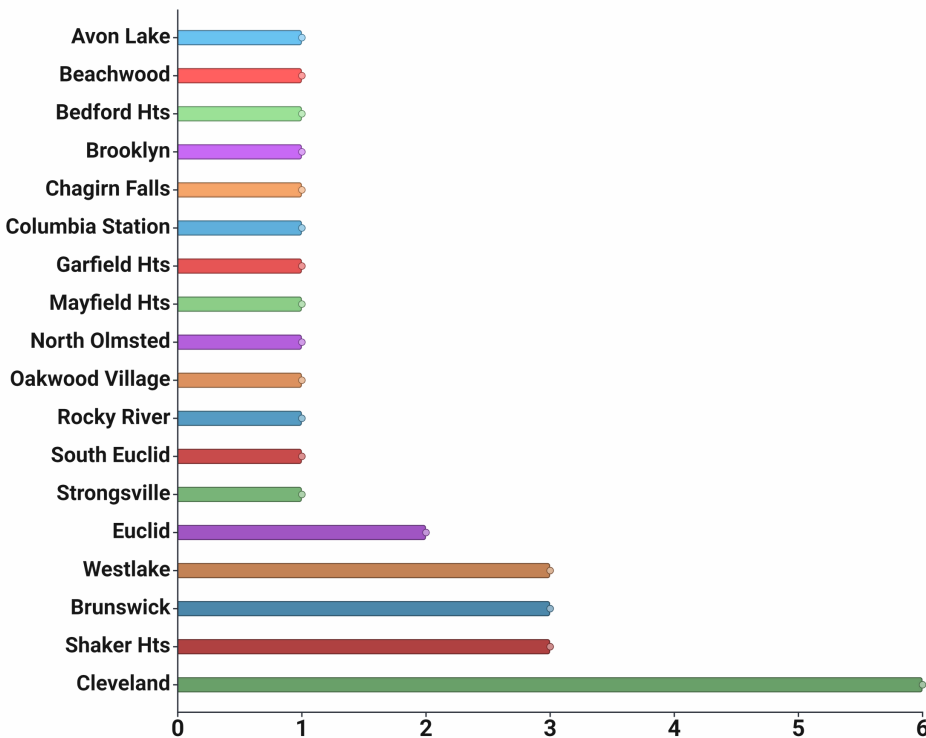
